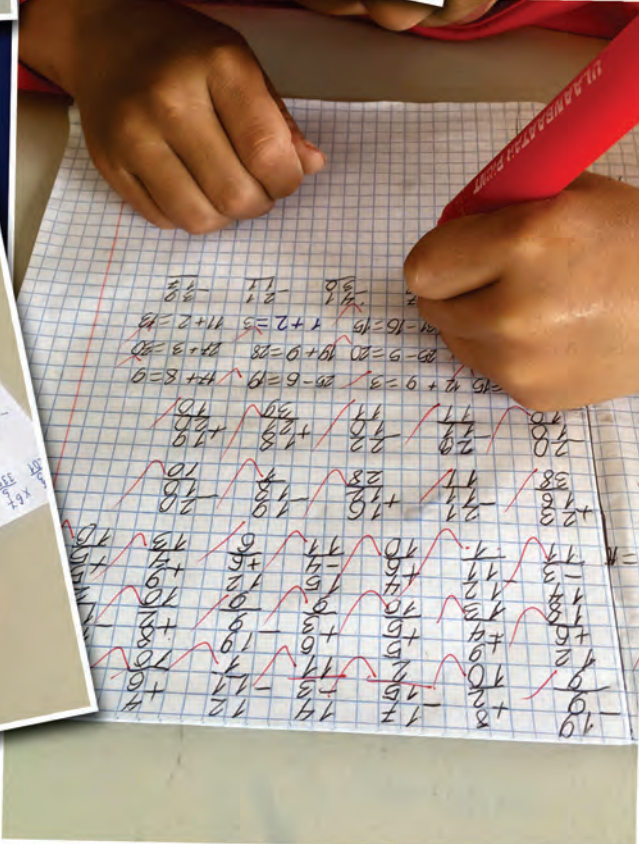
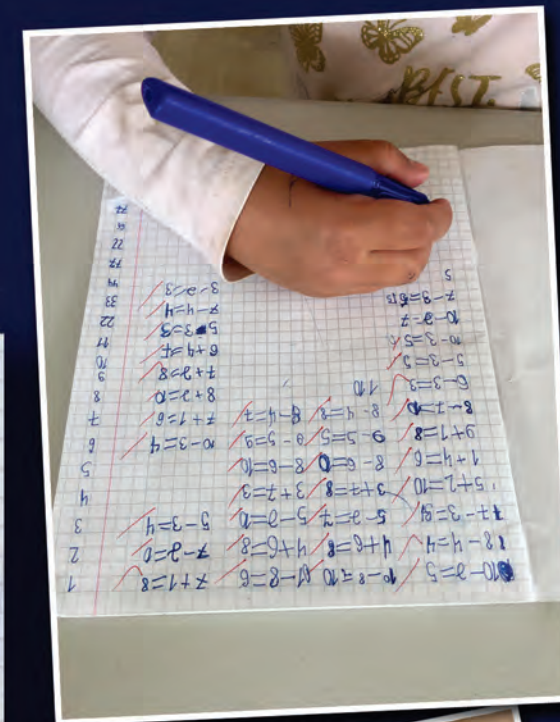


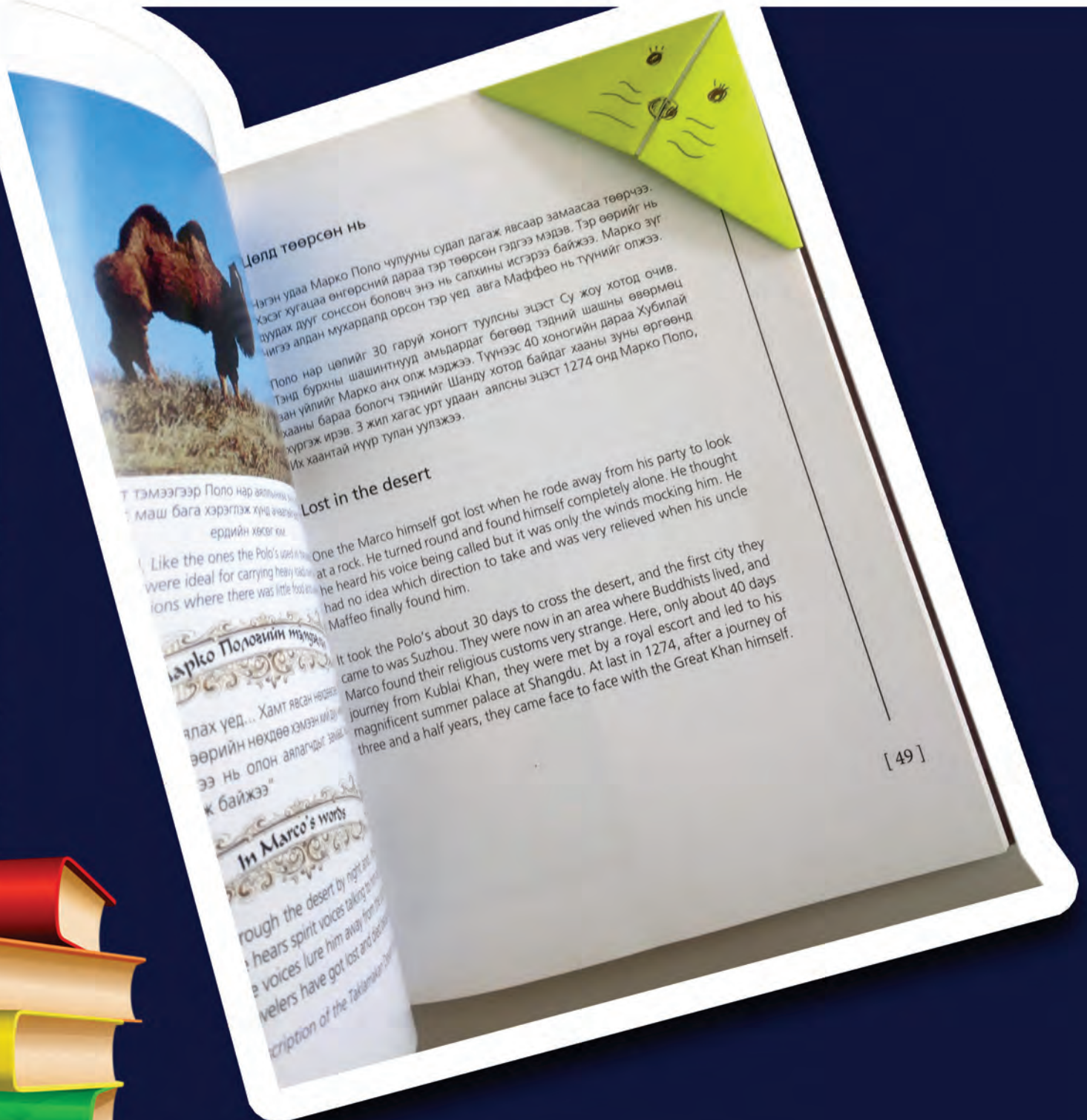
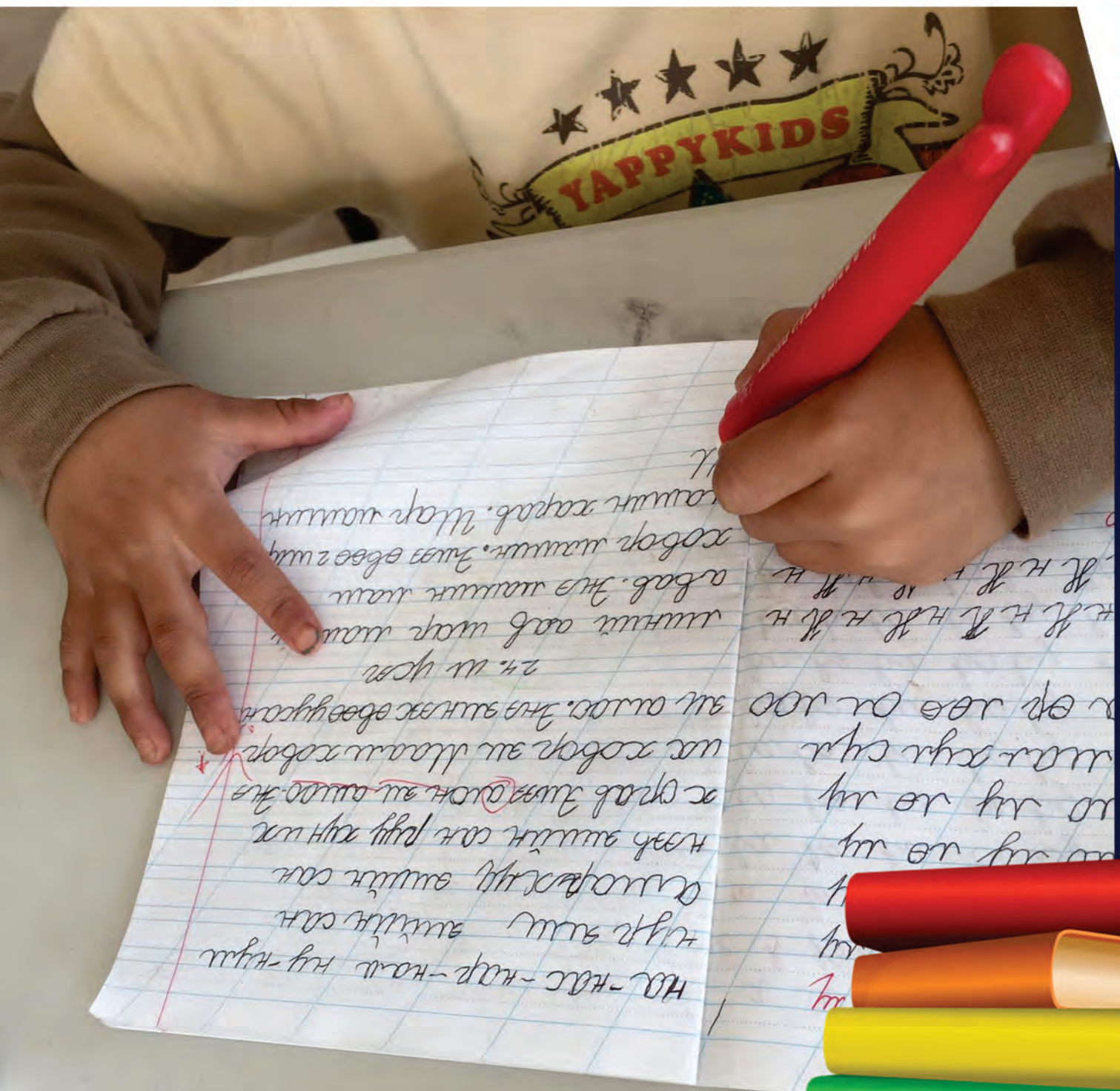


MAGIC MONGOLIA-1 LIBRARY REPORT

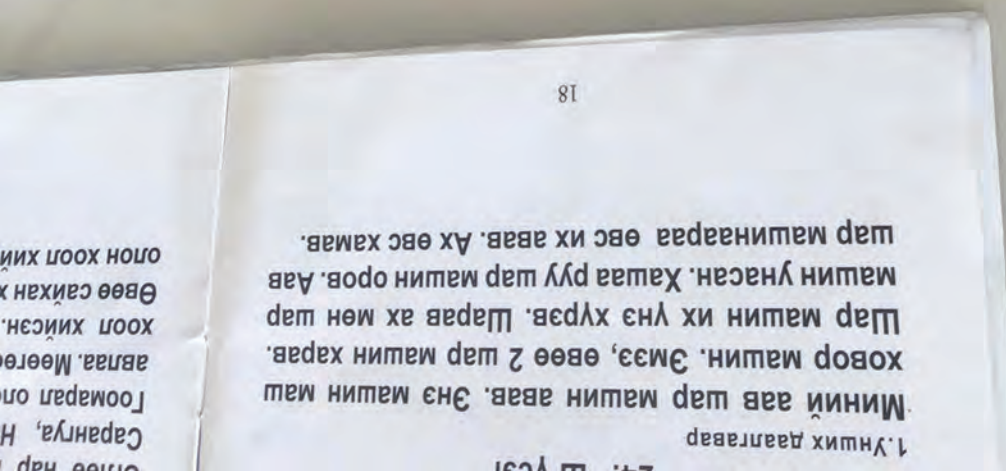


In July, 2020, MMI Center provided math and english lessons for 22 children who were behind on their studies. Of those children, five children received preschool lessons, six children received 1st grade, five children received 2-6th grade, and six children received 7-8th grade lessons. Classes were conducted for 8 hours every day, Monday through Friday, for 2 separate sessions. Each child has shown great progress in their studies.





The book club is teaching library customers how to read a book and write a report about the book they read. They are learning to discuss book topics and express themselves and improving their communication skills.





Children in the protection center are learning to keep their environment clean and learning to garden. They are actively involved in picking up trash and gardening.



We teach middle and high school children how to type with 10 fingers on the computer keyboard and they regularly come to the library and practice on the keyboards.



We taught students how to make paper crafts and they made roses, birds, and bookmarks. After they were done, they decided to give them to their teachers as a gift.
